Fall Furnace Tune Up

Why does everyone push the preventative maintenance you ask? Because simply put it makes your plumbing, heating, or air conditioning equipment last longer. Think of it as an oil change on your car. What happens if you don't take change your oil? Your engine will eventually seize up and quit working. The same thing goes for your air conditioning system. What Gets Done When I Get Preventative Maintenance Done you Might Ask?

- A tech will come to your home or your business and check over the entire furnace or heating system
- They will Test and Check all safety Features. This is essential for proper equipment operation and insures that your system will shut down if there is ever a problem.
- Test all motors and moving parts for proper voltage and amp draws. This
 extends the life of your major electrical components inside your furnace
 or heating system.
- Lubricate all moving parts as per manufacturer's specifications. Poor lubrication causes components to drag and create electrical overload which results in higher bills and equipment failure.
- Check ducts for leaks. Duct leaks in non-conditioned areas will cause poor system performance and improper heating/cooling-results in energy bills
- Test temperature differences. This double checks efficient operation of your furnace or heating system
- Check blower assembly. By maintaining proper alignment and making sure all components are clean, you will insure adequate airflow and increase your comfort.
- Check and adjust burner unit. A dirty or improperly adjusted burner will result in excessive fuel usage and may damage heat exchanger
- Check all filters. Dirty or Blocked Filters can cause Reduced air flow and cause damage to the heat exchanger
- Inspect Heat Exchanger. This is especially important because of the fact
 that if it is cracked and broken, when the furnace runs it will be pushing
 Co2 into your home. If you suspect you might be having problems please
 have this checked out immediately. You don't want to go to bed and not
 wake up.

When was the last time you changed your water filters?

Do you have water filters in your home, maybe under the sink, in your refridgerator, a whole house filter in front of the water softener or where the well piping comes into the home? If so those need to be changed on a schedule just like your furnace in order for proper water flow and sanitary reasons. If you have a refridgerator with an ice maker and water dispensor most likely you have a filter that is inside the refridgerator. Those tend to get pretty grody after about 6 months. If you have a drinking water dispensor at your kitchen sink there is most likely a filter under your sink that needs changed on a regular basis as well. Usually on the filter it will tell you how many gallons they are good for and you can do a rough guess of how long that takes. If you have special filters and are having trouble locating us give us a call and we can locate them for you.

WINTERS COMING WHAT SHOULD I DO AT HOME TO GET READY???

Here is a short list of things that need done around the home before winter sets in for a few months.

Remove your garden hoses from hose bibs, if you leave the hoses on even though it is called a frost free hose bib ice will form in the hose and can travel back inside the hose bib and cause it to freeze and break, they cannot drain all the way if the hose is attached

- Close or cover crawl space vents to prevent freezing air from blowing through and freezing pipes.
- Clean your gutters of leaves so that they can drain right and make sure that they drain into the yard and not the crawlspace
- Have your furnace serviced and gone through to make sure that it is ready to keep you comfortable all winter, is it clean, is the blower motor lubricated and ready to go, is the heat exchanger in tip top shape or is it cracked and pumping CO2 into your home?
- If you heat with a woodstove then make sure your chimney is cleaned and drafting properly
- If you have gas appliances or wood heat make sure batteries in smoke detectors and carbon dioxide detectors are good and the units are functioning.
- Change the furnace filter monthly or as needed to keep your furnace pumping out that heat as efficiently as possible.
- Do you have a fireplace or woodstove for secondary heat, when was the
 last time the chimney was cleaned. That is a very important item to
 check off before winter as the chimney can build up with soot, birds'
 nests, and creosote that can start a chimney fire.

THE OTHER THING TO CONSIDER IS THAT YOU INSTALL A GOOD QUALITY FILTER, IF YOU PICK IT UP AT THE STORE AND CAN SEE CLEARLY THROUGH IT CHANCES ARE IT WILL NOT CATCH MUCH DIRT AND DUST. IF YOU DON'T HAVE A FILTER ALL THAT DUST THAT BUILDS UP ON YOUR COUNTERTOPS IS ALSO BUILDING UP INSIDE YOUR FURNACE AND AIR CONDITIONER AND CAUSING IT TO NOT WORK EFFICIENTLY AS WELL.
